Subject: Re-Organization of the Review and Compliance Committee on Statements of Assets, Liabilities and Networth (SALN)

A. 6713 - "Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees" mandated all government officials and employees to submit Statement of Assets, Liabilities and Networth (SALN) within 30 days upon assumption of office and during such period and as required on a yearly basis. Pursuant to Resolution No. 1300455 promulgated on March 4, 2019, the Institute created a Review and Compliance Committee on SALN on September 20, 2013 (S.O. 311, s. 2013) to evaluate the SALN forms submitted to determine: a) whether submitted on time; b) accomplished completely; and c) proper in form and content.


